We are Yochay and Avital, and we are researchers at a university and at a college.

We are interested in hearing the opinions and points-of-view of children about various subjects; what do children think and feel about their lives?

We are interested in whether or not and how children are satisfied with different aspects in their lives (school, friends, family and more). At the end of the activity, we wish to photograph your artwork before you take it home with you. We promise that any information that arises or that you share with us will remain confidential, meaning no one will know what your answers were.
